

1891. It also housed a School of Art and Science and a City Museum as well as a fire station.

3.9 The construction of the public buildings caused the area to become a popular place to live and the area around the park quickly developed with the terraces in the Boulevard being built around 1891 and Park Terrace being built around 1893.

3.10 It is believed that the row of terraces in Stanley Street that face away from the park do so because the park was originally a recreation ground for the baths and not a public park.

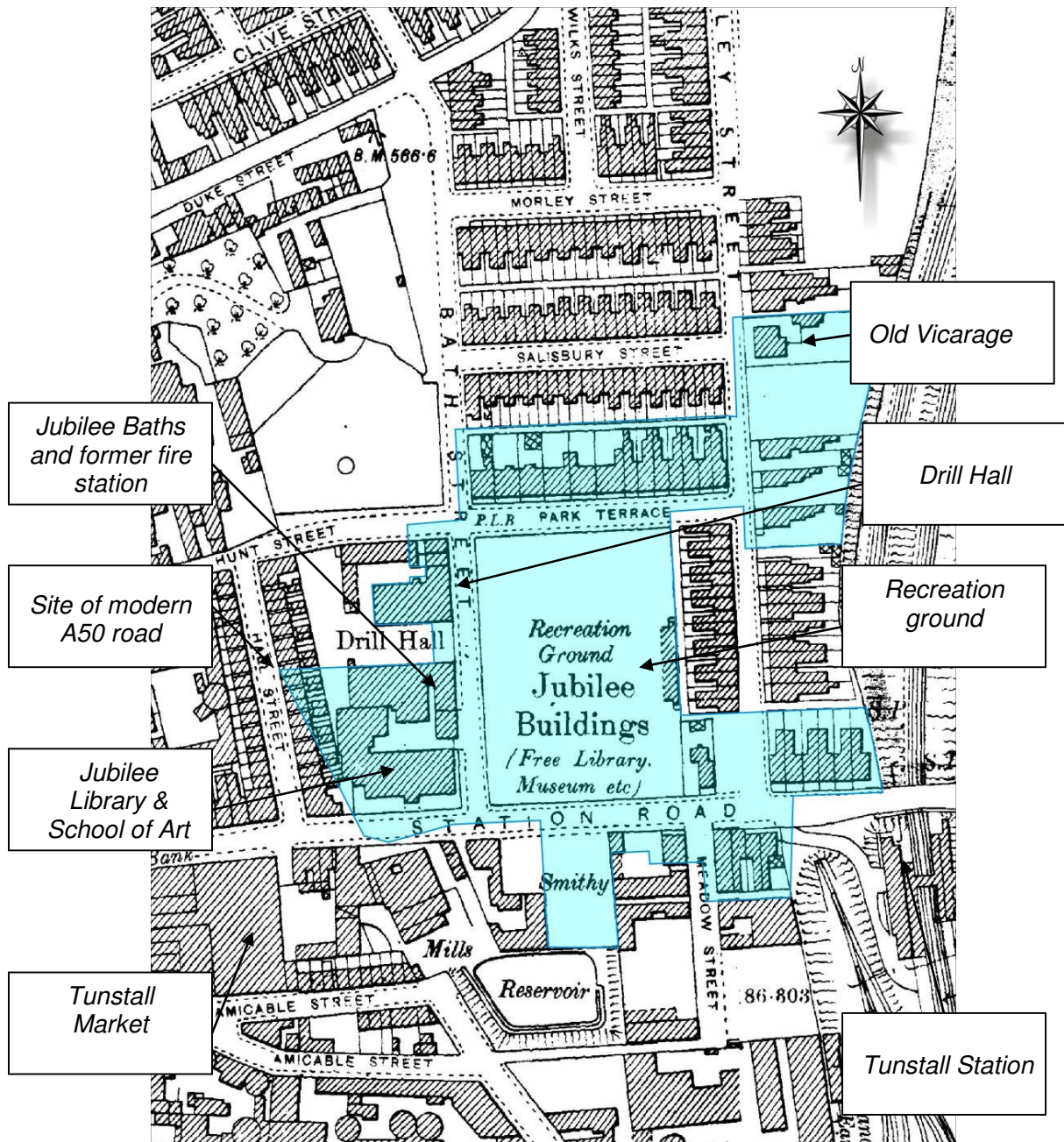


FIGURE 1: Park Terrace in 1900.
